PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT:

The intent of this organization is to have the utmost respect for the community and our sponsors. We also intend to place the respect for our children and the enjoyment of the game above winning or any personal feelings held by parents and spectators. As parents of the players, you join with the coaches and board members to form the North Logan Soccer Association. As an organization, we have the responsibility to uphold and enforce the following codes of conduct.

1. Any problem arising between the parents and the coach must be brought to the attention of a board members within 24 hours. A majority of the board will meet to discuss the problem and resolve the issue. At least one parent and the coach of the team must be present at the board meeting.
2. It is the full responsibility of the parent of each child to pay the required registration fee PRIOR to the first practice. Players will not be allowed to begin practicing with the team unless registration is paid.
3. No foul or abuse language from any spectator will be tolerated toward coaches, referees, other spectators, or board members.
4. It is the parents' responsibility to see that their son/daughter adheres to the Player's Code of Conduct at all times.
5. It is the parents responsibility to see that his/her child attends all scheduled practices and games. If a child cannot attend a practice or game, the parent is responsible for contacting the coach prior to that practice or game. If a written schedule is not received or is lost, it is the responsibility of the parent to contact the coach.

VIOLATION PROCEDURE:

- 1st Offense: Parents will receive a verbal and a written warning from the coach and/or the board.
- 2nd Offense: The offending parent will receive a written notice and be restricted from the playing field for one scheduled game.
- 3rd Offense: The offending parent will be restricted from the remaining scheduled games and/or the player will be separated from the team. No fees will be refunded for separation from the team.
- Severity Clause: The board may move directly to the 2nd or 3rd Offense procedure if a majority of the board members vote that the severity of the offense warrants such action.

Any appeals need to be made within three (3) days of the board's decision.
